

Outreach – Round #1 Summary

Key Findings – themes that emerged as top outcomes

- Manage growth in a way that preserves the character of the City's neighborhoods and heritage.
- Look toward housing options that meet the needs of various demographics from young families to retirees.
- Continue to develop safe and efficient transportation infrastructure into and within Maricopa for all users.
- Center economic development strategies on fostering a business climate that allows for growth in local career-advancing job prospects.
- Attract increased quantities and higher levels of local healthcare services.
- Expand the opportunities for shopping, dining, culture, and recreation destinations.

Outreach - Community Workshop #1 Summary

- Held March 6th, 2025
- 68 attendees
 (52 people signed in)
- 27 post-it notes for feedback on boards
- 84 mapping comments










Outreach – Community Survey #1

Summary

- 585 Total Responses
- 86% full-time residents, 4% seasonal residents, 9% property owner
- Responses from short-, mid-, and long-term Maricopa residents
- Good mix of age groups with a fairly even distribution of those 25 and over.
- Survey closed May 14, 2025



Vision Statement Feedback

 Participants were asked to provide feedback on the Vision Statement in the existing Planning Maricopa General Plan, both shown below.

"The City of Maricopa is a family friendly, vibrant community that offers diverse opportunities in culture, technology, education, business, entrepreneurship, transportation, entertainment, and recreation for all ages. A close knit community of committed leaders, engaged citizens, and diverse partners with pride in our history, and a shared vision for a prosperous future."

- Agree with everything
- I feel like the vision is fine, but the implementation doesn't appear to fit the vision. Maricopa 'feels' like just another suburb for folks that don't want to pay the high housing prices nearer to Phoenix.
- Transportation is a huge problem. We need buses around town (not the MET) AND BUS to Chandler/Tempe/Phoenix/Casa Grande
- It is a very good vision statement but we can truly live up to the ideals mentioned by building a Walkable Downtown.




Summary

 - Increased service infrastructure



 What type of development should the City encourage over the next 20 years?






